

L3 Certificate of Professional Competence for Transport Managers (Road Haulage)

- ✓ This course provides basic knowledge required to set up and run efficient transport operations. It is an industry-recognised qualification, and enables holders to be nominated on a Standard Operator Licence.
- ✓ Holders of the CPC qualification will be accepted as a competent person, and will be entitled by transport law to run and operate transport for hire and reward for themselves or other transport companies.
- ✓ Registered with ELCAS, therefore ELC's can be used to fund part of this course.
- ✓ 35 hours SCPC (optional) payable direct to training provider on the first day of the course.

Who is the course for?

- ◆ The course is for Transport Managers or those aspiring to this role that will have responsibility for the holding of an organisation's Operator's Licence.
- ◆ The course is open to all Service personnel but there is a heavy mathematical content hence you need to be numerate to at least Level 2. You will also be expected to be at least Level 2 for literacy.



Course Structure

The course will cover the following subjects:



- ◆ Civil Law
- ◆ Commercial Law
- ◆ Social Law
- ◆ Fiscal Law
- ◆ Access to the market
- ◆ Technical standards and technical aspects of operation
- ◆ Road safety

At the end of the course, all students will be examined over two 2 hour exams which take place on National exam dates. This will be one multiple choice exam and then a case study exam. Successful attendees will receive the **Level 3 Certificate of Professional Competence for Transport Managers (Road Haulage) (VRQ)**

What support will I receive?

- ◆ A 12 day course with classroom based learning supplemented by directed study and background preparatory reading during the course.
- ◆ Pre-course mandatory reading is essential in order to be successful.
- ◆ There will be a substantial amount of evening and weekend work to prepare you for the exams requiring commitment to a prolonged period of intensive study.
- ◆ You will be provided with experienced and qualified trainers who will help you through every step of this industry recognised qualification.
